

45th Annual *Virtual* Renal Symposium

September 24 & 25, 2020

Overview

This two-day annual event attracts participants from the renal community, including but not limited to nurses, dialysis technicians, social workers, transplant coordinators, case managers and dietitians from major dialysis providers and hospitals such as Fresenius Kidney Care, DaVita, Centers for Dialysis Care, US Renal, the Cleveland Clinic, University Hospitals, and MetroHealth.

Nationally recognized experts provide information regarding renal health care that addresses the latest issues and trends in dialysis and transplantation. Participants earn Continuing Education Units (CEUs). CEUs are available for dietitians, nurses, social workers, dialysis technicians and transplant coordinators.
