WEBINAR: Recovery of Organs From Drug Overdose Deaths

The literature supports the increased use of organs from opioid overdose donors across the country, but little education has been provided to social workers, nurses, and patients regarding the success of these transplants. There are still a large number of patients who turn these kidneys down when they are offered. Nurses and social workers can help educate patients on an ongoing basis as they provide care in the dialysis unit so that patients may be more open to accepting kidneys from these non-traditional donors.
